TODAY: 15th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME: "A sower went out to sow"

-- We read these words in today's Gospel. Christ the Lord is the 'sower' who sows the seed of Eternal Life. He is announcing the coming of God's Kingdom. The sower and the seed are perfect. How successful sowing will be depends on the audience: their disposition, how they receive God's Word and if they want to live it fully. When speaking in parables, our Lord keeps His audience in mind: the blindness of the Pharisees and their stony hearts, and the superficial enthusiasm of the masses of people who carry pride, hatred, and selfishness in their hearts. These attitudes limit their acceptance and understanding of the Words of the **Teacher of Nazareth.**

DANAS: 15. NEDJELJA KROZ GODINU: "Izide sijač sijati" - - - Današnje Evandjelje. Samo je Riječ Božja, Krist Gospodin, sijač koji sije sjeme vječnoga života. Naviješta dolazak Božjeg kraljevstva. Gospodin je gurno, govoreći tu prisposobu, imao pred očima svoje slušatelje: sijeću farizeja i njihova kamenita srca, površno i prolazno oduševljenje masa, prezir njegovih najbližih rođaka i znanaca. Sve je to na svoj način uvjetovalo primanje njegove riječi. Krive su bile predrasude s kojima su susretali Učitelja iz Nazareta, radi kojih predrasuda nisu niti primali njegove riječi onako kako su one bile izgovorene.
