FRIDAY, JUNE 8: at 7:00 P.M.: A special Mass for peace in honor of the Sacred Heart of Jesus celebrated by Fr. Chris. Rosary recitation with parish children and families. Also, if you have pictures of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, bring them with you and Fr. Chris will bless them.

TODAY: CORPUS CHRISTI: Last Sunday we meditated about the mystery of the Most Holy Trinity. Today is the Solemnity of Corpus Christi: the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ. It is the Eucharist; the Body and Blood of the Risen Lord, under the species of bread and wine; His real body and His real blood. This is what the Evangelists emphasize in their writings about Jesus' appearance after His Resurrection. His body is not susceptible to the conditions of life as it was before His Resurrection. The Risen Body is the one that suffered and was crucified, but it possesses new characteristics. So His body is invisible to the human eye. Humans do not perceive the Risen Body and Blood of Jesus during Mass, in the consecrated bread and wine, because all external appearances of bread and wine are there. Jesus is present under the species of bread and wine without any limits to time and space in every communicant; the whole Jesus is given. The Eucharist is the Sacrament of Love. At the Last Supper, before His suffering, dying and rising, Jesus left His beloved Church, His greatest gift: the institution of the Eucharist until the end of the world. He remains among His people, and through Holy Communion He becomes real food for Life Eternal.

DANAS: BLAGDAN TIJELOVA:

Uskrslo Tijelo i Krv Isusovu čovječja osjetila ne zamjećuju u pod svetom Misom, posvećenom kruhu i vinu, premda su od kruha i vina ostale tek vanjske prilike. zahvaljujući svojstvima uskrslog Tijela, Isus je pod prilikama kruha i vina nazoćan bez ograničenja na mjesto i vrijeme i svakom se pričesniku u hostiji daje čitav. Euharistija je sakrament Ljubavj. Pred svoju muku, smrt i uskrsnuće, na posljednjoj večere najviše sto je Isus mogao učiniti za sve svoje ljubljene do konca svijeta, bilo je upravo ustanovljenje Euharistije jer tako se on nalazi mežu svojima i po Prićesti im postaje hrana za Vječni Život.
