TODAY: 16th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME: The Gospel shows us the living Jesus with His young Church. He is the Savior and Shepherd of the Church. The twelve Apostles returned from their first mission journey in Capharnum where they saw a large crowd of people. The Apostles were so busy that they did not have time to eat. Jesus took them from Capharnum and sent them to an out-of-the-way place where they could rest a while. The rest would enable them to resume their evangelization. There was no place where they could spend time with Jesus, so the Apostles decided to go off in a boat with Jesus to a deserted place. When people saw them leave, they told people in surrounding towns that the Apostles were coming to them and many people followed. When Jesus disembarked, and saw the vast crowd, His heart was filled with pity for them, for they were like sheep without a shepherd, and so he began to teach them many things. The Apostles' solitude was over because Jesus felt sorry for the people. Jesus' final word was: "**LOVE**". **The Good Shepherd tried His best to help them, because they were like sheep without a shepherd, so HE TAUGHT THEM MANY THINGS**".

Dobri Pastir, ni ovaj puta nije žalio nikakva truda niti muke, "**Jer bijahu kao ovce bez pastira, pa ih stane poučavati mnogo čemu.**"
