**TODAY: 28th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME:** Jesus looked around and said to His disciples: "**How hard it is for the rich to enter the Kingdom of God.**" The disciples could only marvel at His words. So Jesus repeated what He said: "**My sons, how hard it is to enter the Kingdom of God. It is easier for a camel to pass through a needle's eye than for a rich man to enter the Kingdom of God!**" (Mk 10: 23-25). The true answer to the rich people: "**For man it is impossible, but not for God. With God all things are possible!**" Man cannot be saved by his own power --- because eternal life and Heavenly Kingdom are a gift of mercy and grace, and with God's almightiness His Kingdom can be opened to the rich. Did not Jesus save the rich Levi (Matthew), Zacheus, Magdalen, Nicodemus? . . . All of them understood with their encounter with Jesus that they must follow Him free of earthly possessions .
