TODAY: 29th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME: Our Lord is on the way to Jerusalem with His disciples. He speaks for the third time about His suffering, death and resurrection. The disciples were expecting the Messianic Kingdom to begin; they did not understand Jesus' words. James and John, Zebedee's sons, were privileged people in Jesus' company. Together with Peter they witnessed healing of Jairus' daughter and Jesus' Transfiguration. They wanted greater authority. Peter was on his way to meet them, and so they prayed: "Lord, grant that in Your glory we may be seated one at your right, and the other at Your left." Jesus answered them: **"You do not know what you are saying. Can you drink the cup that I drink, or be baptized with the baptism with which I am baptized?"** Jesus meant the cup of suffering given by His Father's hands in Gethsemane. They accepted Jesus' advice even though they did not understand. Places in Jesus' Kingdom supersede all human calculations. They will be given to those for whom they were prepared. The Baptism that Jesus was talking about is the Baptism of suffering, torture and prison.

LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION: Recommendations to act as sponsors for Baptism or Confirmation can be issued only to registered members of Our Lady of Bistrica Parish who have received the Sacrament of Confirmation, attend Mass and receive Holy Communion regularly. If married, the marriage must be in conformity with the regulations of the Catholic Church.

DANAS: 29. NEDJELJA KROZ GODINU: Gospodin se zajedno sa svojim učenicima nalazi na putu u Jeruzalem. Po treći im je puta navijestio svoju muku, smrt i uskrsnuće. No oni su još uvijek odviše u očekivanju zemaljskog mesijina kraljevstva i stoga ne shvaćaju dubine navještenih riječi. Zebedejevi su sihovi dobro znali, da pripadaju u skup trojice posebno povlaštenih. Zajedno su s Petrom bili svjedoci oživljenju Jairove kćeri, zatim Kristova preobtaženja na Taboru. Sad su odlučili da konačno i definitivno učvrste svoje pozicije i po mogućnosti isključe Petra, koji im je bio najopasniji takmac. Zato su molili: "Daj nam da ti u slavi tvojoj sjednemo jedan s desna, a drugi s lijeva." Isus im na to slikovito odgovara: **"Možete li piti čašu, koju ja pijem?"** Čaša označuje sretnu sudbinu ili još češće nesretnu. Ovdje je Isus mislio na čašu gorčine, čašu trpljenja, gorki kalež, koji će prihvatiti iz Očeve ruke u Getsemaniju. Ivan i Jakob prihvatit će Isusov prijedlog, iako nisu znali što ište. No mjesto u Kristovu kraljevstvu daleko nadilazi svaku ljudsku kalkulaciju. Podijelit će se onima, za koje je pripravljeno. Izraz "kristiti se kristom" također označuje biti dionik iste sudbine, prihvatiti radi nekog teškoće i trpljenje.
