Today's readings- Acts 2:14, 22-23; Psalm 16; 1 Peter 1:17-21; Luke 24: 13-35

TODAY: THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER: On the way to Emmaus, two of Jesus' followers were discussing the bloody events that had recently occurred. While they were talking, Jesus Himself drew near and began to walk with them. They were prevented from recognizing Him. Jesus asked: **"What are you discussing as you walk along?"** The disciple, Cleophas, wondered why anyone would ask. He felt everyone should understand their reason for sorrow and depression. The disciples then told everything that had passed; how Jesus, a prophet mighty in word and deed before God and the people had died tragically and shamefully. They wondered why the chief priests handed Him over to a sentence of death by crucifixion. They spoke of going to the tomb, not finding His body but rather angels announcing that Jesus was alive. They said this was hard to believe. Jesus then spoke, explaining the Scriptures. **"Was it not necessary that the Christ should suffer these things and enter into His glory?"** St Luke stresses that the disciples did not recognize Him because their hearts were still blind. They expected the Messiah to be an earthly king who would free His people and make them rulers on earth. They did not understand God's plan.

Nikako im ne idu u glavu krvavi događaji posljednjih dana. Hoće ih Isus osloboditi teške žalosti i razočaranosti koja poput more pritište njihove duše? Hoće li Ga prepoznati i gdje? Isusovo prvo pitanje: **"Što to putem pretresate među sobom?"** otvara dijalog. Kleofa se čudi što netko takvo pitanje uopće i postavlja. Kao da bi svatko morao znati razlog njihove žalosti i potištenosti. Na Isusovo drugo pitanje: **"Što se to dogodilo...?"**, učenici počеше pripovijedati o svemu: Sjećaju se nezaboravne prošlosti: **"Isus bijaše prorok silan na djelu i riječi pred Bogom i svim narodom"**.... Svršio je tako tragično i sramotno: "Glavari ga svećenički i vijećnici naši razapeše..." Istina neke žene govore da su ga vidjele živa, ali to se ne može vjerovati.... Isus preuzima riječ. Tumači Pisma. Tu je njegova riječ: "Zar nije trebalo da Krist sve to pretrpi te ude u svoju slavu?" Evanđelista Luka želi istaknuti da Ga učenici nisu prepoznali radi toga, jer su njihova srca bila slijepa. Imali su krivu sliku o Mesiji: nadali se zemaljskom moćniku koji će osloboditi svoj narod, a njima dodijeliti prva mjesta, a sad su s njegovom smrću sve nade pokopane.
