Today's readings- Acts 1: 12-14; Psalm 27; 1 Peter 4: 13-16; John 17: 1-11a

TODAY: SEVENTH SUNDAY OF EASTER: What did Jesus accomplish? He gave eternal life to those the Father entrusted to Him... those who knew and accepted Jesus as the Son of God. They loved Him completely even to the point of giving up their own lives. Christ is the most glorified through them. Every man can be a glorification of God. Saints especially glorify Jesus Christ because in them and through them Christ walks the earth again. Jesus prays for all His disciples. He is not praying for those who do not accept His message, who reject His Light. These are already condemned because they have not believed in the One sent by the Father. St. John writes: **"Here is the choosing of eternity. A person who believes, lives eternal life here on earth. This life is started and once in eternity will blossom in its fullness."**

VOCATIONS: Jesus has returned in glory to the Father in heaven, not to abandon us, but to lead us to where he hopes we will follow. How are you called to lead others to heaven? If God is calling you to a Church vocation, call Fr. Andrew Lauricella at 716-847-5535.
