TODAY: 15TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME: "A sower went out to sow" --- words in today's Gospel. Christ, the Lord is the 'sower' who sows the seeds of Eternal Life. He is announcing the coming of God's Kingdom. The sower and the seed are perfect. The success of the sowing depends on the audience: their characters- whether they truly want to live out God's Word. Our Lord knows the blindness of the Pharisees with their stony hearts. He understands the superficial enthusiasm of the crowds of people who carry pride, hatred and selfishness within them. These attitudes limit their acceptance and understanding of the Words of the **Teacher of Nazareth** found within the parables.

Sve je to na svoj način uvjetovalo primanje njegove riječi. Krive su bile predrasude s kojima su susretali Učitelja iz Nazareta, radi kojih predrasuda nisu niti primali njegove riječi onako kako su one bile izgovorene.
